



## SECURITY TRAINING FOR FEMALE BUSINESS TRAVELERS

### GOAL:

The share of female business travelers is constantly increasing. Their particular needs and specific risks must be considered when preparing them for trips abroad. Criminals often consider women an easy target; hence female travelers tend to be victimized disproportionately often. In addition, cultural idiosyncrasies of many regions of the world, such as appropriate behavior of women in business, pose challenges for traveling women.

Corporate Trust's security training for female travelers has been developed with these requirements in mind and is conducted by a female trainer.

The objective of the training is to increase employees' awareness about risks abroad and provide advice on how to mitigate potential emergency situations such as robbery.

The training is based on images of scenarios and videos showing realistic threat situations in different regional and cultural contexts.

Participants analyze these threat scenarios in working groups and develop counter-measures that are discussed among all participants. The training focuses on situations female travelers face in daily life, such as using cash machines or taxis. The scenarios can be adapted to regions and countries chosen by the client.

### RESULTS:

Participants discuss emergency situations on the basis of realistic scenarios, followed by the trainer's explanation of the respective correct behavior. As a result, course participants will be able to anticipate risks and minimize them through appropriate action.

### TRAINERS:

The trainers at Corporate Trust are experts in travel security and challenging cultural environments.

### CONTENT AND AGENDA:

1. Basics of travel security and general security advice for travel abroad
2. Introduction to country-specific scenarios (one or several countries)
  - Terrain orientation, highlighting the traveler's specific local challenges, such as hotspots, dangerous neighborhoods, and geographic location of their accommodation and project sites
  - Regional and country-specific risks (e.g. kidnapping or sexual harassment)
3. Workshop
  - Course participants analyze threat scenarios in day-to-day situations and develop preventive security measures
  - Discussion and evaluation of results
  - Conclusion: TOP 10 DO's and DONT's for female travelers
