Even though today's Germany is a very safe country, such attacks do still take place every year. Those affected are usually individuals whose professional or social position puts them in the public eye and are who are known to be wealthy. The perpetrators of these crimes are increasingly targeting the family members of such individuals, as this puts the rest of the family under greater psychological strain and makes them more likely to give in to demands.
